On this walk you might see:


If out at dawn or dusk you may see roe deer and possibly red deer too. Buzzards can often be seen soaring on the thermals as you look out from the view point bench towards Aisholt Common.

Did you know? There is evidence of 23 lime kilns in the Quantock Hills, with this one at Hawkridge being the only fully restored example.
